

## H1N1 (SWINE FLU) MASS VACCINATION CLINIC (MVC) SCHEDULE

Changes to these dates and times, including inclement weather cancellations, will be posted on the Carroll County Health Department's website at [www.carrollhealthdepartment.dhmdh.gov](http://www.carrollhealthdepartment.dhmdh.gov) and the Flu Line [410-876-3003](tel:410-876-3003).

**These clinics are open to the general population age 6 months and older.** Those individuals in the target groups are still highly encouraged to receive the vaccine as they are at higher risk for complications from H1N1. The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) priority groups are:

- Pregnant women
- Household contacts and caregivers for children younger than 6 months of age
- Healthcare and emergency medical services personnel
- Children and young adults aged 6 months to 24 years
- Persons aged 25 through 64 with health conditions that place them at greater risk of medical complications from influenza

Remember, we cannot vaccinate children younger than 6 months of age. It is important to note that children 9 years of age and under need to receive a 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of H1N1 vaccine 4 weeks or 28 days after their 1<sup>st</sup> dose. If it has been longer than 4 weeks or 28 days since your child's first dose, this is NOT an issue. However, it is still recommended that children 9 years of age and younger DO receive a 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of the H1N1 vaccine. The H1N1 vaccine is FREE and anyone who would like the vaccine, over the age of 6 months, is able to attend the clinic.
