
NAMING OF PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITIES

I. PURPOSE

To set forth a procedure for the naming of new schools.

III. POLICY STATEMENT

The Board of Education of Carroll County encourages and supports community participation and involvement in the public schools. Schools and members of the community should have the opportunity to present suggestions for names of public school facilities. The name of a public school facility should be one which gives proper recognition to it and to the community which it serves. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS POLICY PERTAIN TO THE NAMING OF SCHOOL FACILITIES ONLY. PORTIONS OF THE SCHOOL FACILITY, SUCH AS A GYMNASIUM, LIBRARY, AUDITORIUM, STADIUM, FIELDS, AND OTHER AREAS USED TO PROVIDE ANCILLARY SERVICES IN THE CARROLL COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM ARE NOT NAMED.
