The following scholarships are available in the School Counseling Office or on the North Carroll High School Website. If you are interested in receiving an application or further information about one of the listed scholarships, stop in the counseling office. Also check the websites of the college(s) you are looking at applying to attend. Many colleges have scholarships that you can apply to if you are accepted at that college.

1. **ABBOTT AND FENNER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM-** \$1000 Will be awarded to a student who writes an essay on the topic What was the most difficult time in your life, and why? 2. **AES ENIGENNERING Scholarship-** One \$500 award will be given to a student based on character determined by a submitted essay.
