(Private, parochial and home-school examples may also be utilized as illustrations of an individual or group response to First Amendment law.) Identify how this particular claim is a part of the broader narrative of the right to freedom of religion, conscience or belief in the United States. Use legal and historical analysis to analyze and evaluate this type of claim. Reference academically respected sources that give hearing to more than one side of this debate, and sources that give background on the basis for differing interpretations.

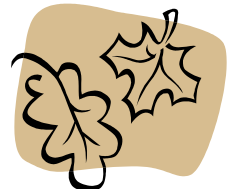
#### **Robert H. Goddard Historical Essay Award**
