SJ Brady STOP Hunger Scholarships – Deadline: Dec 5, 2011. Award: \$5,000. Eligibility: All high school students enrolled in an accredited educational institution in the U.S. Application is available online at: www.studentscholarships.org/scholarship.php.

NHS Scholarship Program – Nomination Deadline: Jan 20, 2012. Award: \$10,000. State finalists receive \$1,000; State winners receive \$1,500; regional winners receive \$3,000 and national winner receives \$13,000 award. Eligibility: Students who are seniors in good standing are eligible to be nominated by their NHS chapters to compete. Only active chapters can submit nominations. NHS Advisors must login to begin the nomination. NHS Chapters may nominate 4 seniors to compete. Davidson Fellows Scholarship – Preliminary Submission Overview Form Due: Jan 16, 2012. Nomination Deadline: Feb 1, 2012. Awards: \$50,000, \$25,000 and \$10,000. Eligibility: Student must be 18 or younger as of Oct 4, 2012; U.S. citizen; Students whose projects are at or close to the college graduate level with a depth of knowledge in their particular area of study. This scholarship is not geared toward students at the novice level. Various application categories and project criteria. Visit www.davidsongifted.org/fellows/ for application and information.

Odenza Marketing Scholarship – Deadline: March 30, 2012. Award: \$500. Eligibility: Students between the ages of 16 and 25 on March 30, 2012; Submit answers to the essay questions found on the online application page; Have at least one full year of post secondary studies remaining at the time of award; GPA of 2.5 or greater; U.S. or Canada resident. Apply online at www.odenzascholarships.com/application.php.

Healthy Lifestyles Scholarship – Deadline: May 30, 2012. Award: \$5,000. Eligibility: Students must be between the ages of 15 – 21 as of May 30, 2012; U.S. or Canada resident; Be a full time student in 2012 in either high school or college/university; and answer the essay question found on the application in 500 words or less. Big Dig Scholarships – Deadline: June 1, 2012. Award: \$3,000. Eligibility: Must be currently in grade 12 and planning on entering into your first year of college/university in 2012. Man Mac Automatic Scholarship – Deadline: June 15, 2012. Award: \$500. Eligibility: Student must be enrolled in an undergraduate program by the Fall of 2012. The school you attend must be located within Canada or the United States.; Student must have a GPA of at least 2.75 in last academic year; Submit Letter of Recommendation from Parent/Guardian and complete online application: www.transmissionkamloops.com/kamloops.html.

BBG Communications Scholarship – Deadline: June 30, 2012. Award: \$1,000. Eligibility: Student must be between the ages of 16 and 21 on June 30, 2012; submit answers to the two essay questions, which can be found on the application page; Have at least one full year of post-secondary studies remaining at the time of the award; Have a GPA of 2.5 or greater; and be a citizen of the United States or Canada. 2012 NFIB Young Entrepreneur Foundation (YEF) Scholarship – Deadline: December 15, 2011. Award Varies: From \$1,000 to \$10,000. Eligibility: Student accepted to a college who has operated and owned a small business. A NFIB member nomination is required for semi-finalist students. Must apply online at www.NFIB.com/YEA. Click on “Apply Now” button.

American Legion High School Oratorical Contest – Deadline: January 13, 2012. Eligibility: High school students under age 20 and citizens of the United States are eligible. Competition begins at the post level and advances to a state competition. Legion department representatives certify one winner per state to the national contest, where department winners compete against each other in two speaking rounds. The contest caps off with a final round that decides the three top finishers. Application is available in the Counseling Center and must be submitted no later than January 13, 2012.
