
STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE ON BOARD OF EDUCATION

- I. **PURPOSE**
To provide for the involvement of a student in the decision making of the Board of Education of Carroll County.
- II. **DEFINITIONS**
Student Representative - the student elected annually by the Carroll County Student Government Association (CCSGA) to serve on the Board of Education.
- III. **POLICY STATEMENT**
Each year an official student representative shall be appointed to the Board of Education. The student representative will be provided the opportunity to vote on issues before the Board, except personnel matters. The vote ~~should indicate the position of the students~~ **WILL REFLECT AN INFORMED STUDENT OPINION** and will be recorded but will not count in the ~~determination for action~~ **COUNTED TOWARDS THE DETERMINATION OF ACTION ON BOARD POLICY, CURRICULUM, PUBLICATIONS, AND OTHER STUDENT-RELATED ITEMS. THE VOTE WILL BE RECORDED AND NOT COUNTED TOWARDS DECISIONS REGARDING THE CAPITAL AND OPERATING BUDGETS, BIDS AND CONTRACTS, SCHOOL CLOSINGS AND OPENINGS, SCHOOL BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENTS, AND STUDENT DISCIPLINARY MATTERS.** The Board of Education will seat the official student representative annually at the June Board of Education meeting.
- IV. **EXCEPTIONS**
Executive sessions involving confidential information will be closed to the student representative.
- V. **GUIDELINES**
