Classes Student

Can take: Students can take one course at a time, however can take as many courses as necessary during the year

Format: Online

Dates: Starting Monday, September 13 – Every Monday and Wednesday

There will be no D.L.L. when schools are closed or on early dismissal days

Location: Century High School in the Media Center

Time: 3:00 – 5:00 p.m. Students should arrive at 2:50 and depart no later than 5:10

Cost: \$150.00 - Pay by cash, check or money order made out to Century High School. Please put the name of the registered student on the check or money order. No credit card payments will be accepted. No tuition waivers will be given.

Registration: Students complete an application in the guidance office. After payment is received and their application is approved by their guidance counselor, they can begin the program.

The last day applications will be approved is Friday, April 8.

- Refunds: There are no refunds.

- Grading: Grade reports will be mailed home when the student has completed the class.
- Attendance: Regular attendance is required. A student who is absent more than three days for any reason while enrolled in a course for credit recovery will not receive credit or a tuition refund for his/her DLL course. Three times tardy will equal one absence.
- Rules: Violation of county policies and/or established rules and regulations while attending the D.L.L. program may affect eligibility for extracurricular activities. Please read the rules and regulations in the Student Handbook of Rules and Regulations that your student has received from Century High this year. Conduct and behavior which are prohibited during the regular school day are also prohibited during the D.L.L. program.
- Students may not leave campus while attending the program without written permission from parents – NO EXCEPTIONS!
 - Foods and soft drinks are not allowed in the computer lab
 - Possession and/or use of tobacco on school property or in a vehicle is prohibited. Possession of weapons is prohibited.
 - Use, possession, transfer, or sale of alcohol, narcotics, depressants, stimulants, hallucinogens, or “look alike” drugs, unless taken by prescription under the direction of a physician, is prohibited.
 - Students should dress for the program in clothing that reflects cleanliness, decency, and modesty. In case of disagreement as to what is “inappropriate,” “offensive,” “distracting,” etc., the staff opinion shall prevail.
