Dear Families,

Field trips are an important part of a child's elementary school experience. Our staff works very hard to select trips that are both educational and memorable for our students. We know that the downturn in the economy is affecting the financial situation for many of our families so we are trying to keep the cost of field trips reasonable. We don't ever want a child to miss a field trip because the family can't afford it; if you are unable to pay for the field trip, please contact Mrs. Townsend or Mrs. Hicks.

Chaperones are critical to the success of these trips and we are grateful to those of you who assist with the supervision of our students. Please remember that in order to be selected as a chaperone, you must have completed the Volunteer Training at least seven days prior to the field trip. Mrs. Williar offers many training sessions throughout the school year; please don't wait until the last minute to get Volunteer Training.

If you are selected to be a chaperone, we are asking that you adhere to the following guidelines:

- Sign in (and out) on the volunteer computer
- Model appropriate behavior
- Avoid socializing with other adults
- Stay with the group and stick to the planned itinerary
- NO SMOKING AT ANY TIME!
- Dress appropriately
- Report any discipline concerns to a classroom teacher

Health Room Notes

Information Regarding Transportation and Storage of Medication

Medication shall be brought in by a responsible adult. In accordance with our Drug and Alcohol procedure, students shall not carry medication with them. Asthma inhalers or other emergency medications may be carried if a physician's order to carry is on file in the health room. The school nurse will assess the student's knowledge and ability to self-administer any medication. If students are found to be improperly using medications they carry, parents and physicians will be contacted to ascertain if that practice should be continued. Any students who have transported medication to school without prior authorization shall be reported to the administration immediately.

The following items are not considered to be medications and therefore students may carry them without being in violation of our drug and alcohol procedure:

- Chapsticks/Lip Balm
- Non-medicated cough drops (e.g. Ludens)
Medicated cough drops - any cough drops which indicate limit per day require Dr.'s order (e.g. Cepacol, Robitussin w/cough syrup)
- Saline eye drops, wetting solution and real tears - contact lens/wetting
- Saline nose spray
- Hand creams/lotions
- Sunscreen
- Waterless hand cleanser
