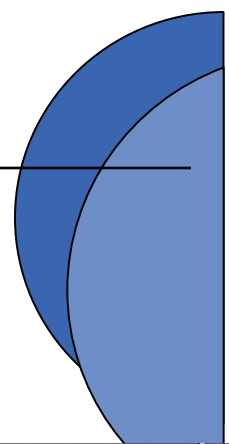

DEADLINE May 4th

Carroll County 4-H Livestock Club Scholarship

DEADLINE June 15th

Carroll County Food Services Association

DEADLINE May 1st

Graduating senior pursuing an undergraduate degree at an accredited college, university, or culinary arts school. GPA 3.0, worthy SAT scores, demonstrated interest in pursuing a college degree or career in culinary arts, or a related field.

DEADLINE April 15th

One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a Carroll County student who plans to pursue the dramatic arts in college. The student does not have to become a Drama major, he or she must plan on using the dramatic arts in his or her chosen field of study....drama teacher, stage craft, drama therapy etc.

Carroll County Football League Scholarship

DEADLINE April 30th

\$500 scholarship for students who played football with the C.C.F.L. for at least three years.

CCEA Future Teacher Scholarship

DEADLINE March 31st

Awarded to any student entering collage with a major in education regardless of whether or not they are the child or grandchild of a member.

CCEA Membership Scholarship

DEADLINE March 31st

Awarded to children or grandchildren of current, retired, or deceased CCEA members regardless of the recipient's educational goals or place of residence.

Celebrate Youth Scholarship

DEADLINE April 15th

Scholarship(s) will be awarded each year to students who meet the following criteria: must be a resident of Carroll County, a graduating senior, been accepted at post-secondary institution, maintained GPA of 3.25 or higher, shown outstanding citizenship traits and have been involved in student service activities and extra-curricular activities in Carroll County during their high school career.

Carroll County Volunteer Emergency Services Scholarship

DEADLINE April 15th

Program applicants must have Fire/EMS service affiliation, be a relative of a bona fide volunteer or paid Firefighter/EMS in a member company of the CC Volunteer Emergency Services Association. Must have at least 2.5 GPA, and acceptance or enrollment in MD College.

Class of 1930 Nursing Scholarship

DEADLINE MAY 1st

All students graduating from the CCCTC Nursing Program are eligible to apply.

DEADLINE APRIL 15th

All applicants must have a grade point average of 3.0 or above for the entire school year, shown outstanding citizenship traits. Students enrolled in Engineering courses at the Carroll Career and Technology Center will be given special consideration.

DEADLINE JUNE 30th

John J. Mazur Jr 4-H Scholarship

DEADLINE June 15th

Awarded to students who are present members of 4-H in Carroll County, graduating seniors or high school graduates, accepted at or already attending college or post-secondary school, carried a livestock or photography project at 4-H.

New Windsor Lions Club

DEADLINE April 15th

\$1000 Scholarship to a graduating senior from the New Windsor Middle School attendance area. Scholarship based on grades, service to school and community, personal qualities, need, effort, and participation in extra-curricular activities.

DEADLINE April 29th
