IMPORTANT GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

In order for a senior to be eligible to participate in graduation exercises they must complete the Maryland state graduation requirements by the end of the fourth marking period of their senior year. Seniors who are required to attend summer school after the date of graduation to make-up or meet requirements **will not** be able to participate in graduation exercises until the following year. Check with your senior to be certain that the requirements have been or are scheduled to be met and that course work is being completed satisfactorily.

We encourage **ALL** Seniors who are looking at post-secondary education to check out scholarships. There are monies available for technical, business & art schools, community colleges, & four-year colleges.
