

any injured child and then we will follow your preferences as listed on the emergency card. It is imperative that there is always someone to call in case of emergency. Please list ALL people who have your permission to pick up your child from school. The school policy is to notify the parents when children get sick or hurt. We will not release children to someone whose name is not on the card without a written note. You will be asked to show identification.

Field Trips: Field trips are planned to coordinate with classroom work. Students must have written consent from parent/legal guardian before going on any field trip. Parents, who are invited to chaperone and have had volunteer training, may ride the bus. Parents may not transport their child to or from a field trip and are asked to not meet them at the destination. Children who are not enrolled at Linton Springs are not to be included on these trips.

Homework: Cooperation between parents and teachers is essential for effective home study. The teacher's role is to provide assignments that will enrich and reinforce school experiences. The parent's role is to provide conditions conducive to study and to help the child determine a good study schedule, but not to teach or to do the homework. **HOMEWORK CAN ONLY BE REQUESTED WHEN A STUDENT WILL BE OUT MORE THAN ONE (1) DAY.**

Personal Possessions: Valuables such as extra money, sports equipment, radios, cd players, ipods, electronic toys, etc. are **NOT** to be brought to school. Sports cards and other collectibles are also **not** to be brought to school.

Transportation: Parents are required to select and adhere to one permanent daily am/pm bus stop which can only be changed in the case of an emergency and with the principal's approval. It is extremely important for the safety of our children that all children follow the general rules of safety when riding to and from school each day. Parents are responsible for the conduct and safety of their children in the morning and afternoon at the bus stop. Discipline at the bus stop is the responsibility of the parents. Pupils who misbehave on the bus may have their bus riding privileges suspended. Parents will be notified when their child is reported to the office for poor bus behavior. Continued unacceptable behavior on the bus which endangers the safety of the children may result in suspended bus privileges. **Children will not be permitted to ride any bus other than their own.**

Volunteers: We welcome parents/guardians who are interested in volunteering in various capacities. Volunteer training is **REQUIRED** by CCPS and will be provided at the school. Training is **mandatory** for parents to volunteer in the classroom and chaperone school field trips.
