The IA-IIA West Region Final Playoff Game in girls lacrosse at Winters Mill last night was hard fought by our Lady Mavericks who finished 11-4 on the season. Winters Mill pulled away in the second half to win 18-10. Our girls mounted a furious rally near the end of the first half to close the half with a 9-8 deficit. Hannah Clinton made 15 saves as goalie, Taylor Gress scored 3 goals, Colby Unkle scored 2, and Taylor Carhart, Katelyn Catrano, Allie Colson, Abbey Dasch, and Allie Little all scored a goal.
