# COURSE SELECTION

This Course Selection Worksheet must be brought with you when you and your parent meet with your academic advisor on February 3 or February 9 to select your courses for the 2011-2012 school year. A postcard will be sent to you with your appointment date and time. Please call 410.386.1673 if you need to reschedule.

**COURSE SELECTION:** All eleventh grade students must choose appropriate courses in English, Social Studies, Science, and Mathematics as well as enough courses to total exactly eight (8.0) credits. Other elective courses chosen should meet graduation requirements (Fine Arts, Technology Education, etc.) and/or reflect a specific career focus.

**PREREQUISITES:** Please review the Program of Studies booklet to ensure prerequisites for each course have been met. The Course Selection sheet includes notification of prerequisites when required. Courses requiring the signature of a teacher or counselor are indicated in the Approval column and must be completed before turning in the form.

**ALTERNATE COURSES:** Students should select four alternate courses. Two courses should be one (1.0) credit courses, and two courses should be half (0.5) credit courses. These alternates will be assigned should your first choice not be available.

**COURSE LEVELS:** Course levels are indicated on the Course Selection Sheet. Definitions of the levels and actual course numbers are listed in the Program of Studies. The last digit of the six-digit number indicates level. The number 1 denotes Basic Level, 6 denotes Academic Level, 8 denotes Honors Level. Example: 051016R: GP Literature & Composition (Academic Level); 051018R: GP Literature and Composition (Honors Level).

**HIGH SCHOOL ASSESSMENTS:** Students enrolled in Algebra, Biology, Global Perspectives, and Government must pass the Maryland High School Assessment for that course.

Manchester Valley High School will make every effort to schedule all the courses that you select. However, we reserve the right to make changes when conflicts occur.

I understand that I must make appropriate choices and am expected to follow my printed schedule. Teachers are hired and books and materials are purchased based on students' course selections.
