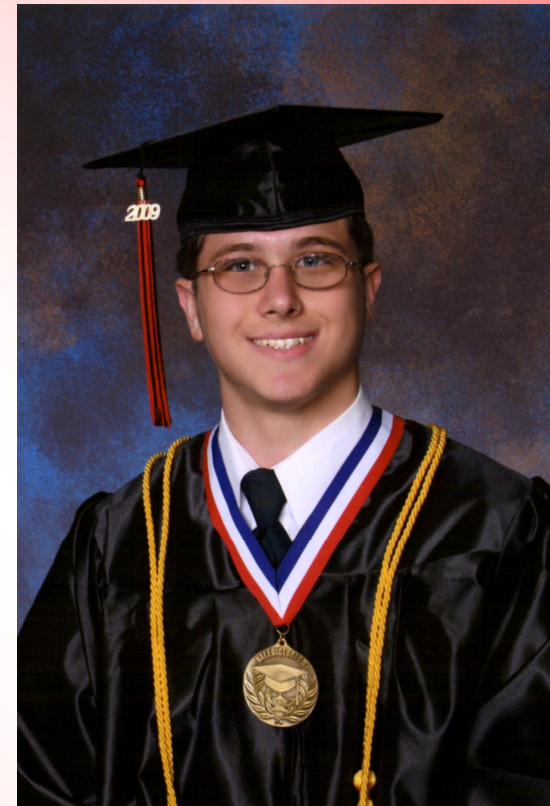

Graduation Dress Code

Gentlemen

- Black robe with black cap and 2012 tassel
White dress shirt (long or short sleeve)
- Solid dark-colored tie (no patterns), preferably black
- Dark (navy or black) dress slacks
- Black dress shoes (no sneakers!)
- Black dress socks



Graduation Dress Code



Ladies

- Red robe with red cap and 2012 tassel
- Solid light-colored dress (no patterns or bright colors)
- Black low-heeled dress shoes (no flip-flops)

Notes for everyone

- No jewelry or flowers are to worn on the gown other than school service awards and honor pins.
- Gowns should NOT be ironed.
- Gowns should be removed from their bags and allowed to hang loosely for at least ONE WEEK before graduation rehearsals.
- Students who do not arrive in appropriate clothing will not be allowed to participate in the Farewell Assembly, Community Awards, or Graduation.
