Fundraising Information

- *Letter writing campaign will take place as the main fall fundraiser. Letter to be revised by Troy and then copies will need to be made. Dollar amounts to be changed to 20, 40, 60, 80 and other. Each fall sport will need one team parent to assist with this campaign. This fundraiser will be introduced on Meet the Coach night.

- *Robin will check with local Pizza shops to get best possible price for concessions. Currently using Pizza Boli at \$6 per pizza (8 slices)
- *January is the Boosters Bingo month. Looking to do either Longaberger or Vera Bradley or some combination.
- *Discussed holding a Golf Tournament in June at either Oakmont or Piney Branch. Will need to make a decision on this and book a date soon.

*All teams must participate in fundraisers through the boosters.
