

# *Husky Learning Lab*

## **An Afterschool Program to Help Students With Homework, Classwork, and Test Preparation**

### **How does it work?**

- The Husky Learning Lab runs Monday through Thursday beginning on September 21.
- There is no Learning Lab the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of each month, on early dismissal days, or on evening conference nights.

- Students have written permission from their parent/guardian to attend as well as information on how the student will get home (ie. Walk, Pick-Up).
- Students turn the permission slip in to their homeroom teacher or bring it to Husky Learning Lab.
- Students are called to the Media Center with the last wave of buses.
- Students are expected to bring all of their assigned work with them to the media center.
- Students may use computers but only if it pertains to an assignment.
- When students complete work they are expected to read silently.
- All students are expected to stay at the Learning Lab until 4:30.

### **What are the times of the program?**

- The program runs from about 3:40 until 4:30.
- Parents/Guardians are expected to pick up their students at 4:30. Students who are walking home will be dismissed at 4:30 as well.

### **Who is there to help?**

- Each day there is a math teacher available to assist students.
- On Monday and Wednesday a Science teacher is also available.
- On Tuesday and Thursday an RLA and a Social Studies teacher are also available.
