**Maryland PTA Scholarship** – Deadline: March 15, 2012. Award: \$500. Eligibility: High School seniors who plan to pursue a career in education in the public schools of Maryland. All applicants must have a 2.75 un-weighted minimum GPA and demonstrated financial need. Student must obtain the signature/sponsorship of a Maryland PTA President and verify the PTA is in good standing. Check with your middle or elementary school PTA president for the sponsorship signature. Application is available in the Counseling Center.

**Wofford Scholars Program (Nomination)** – Deadline: April 1, 2012. Award: \$3,000 per year up to full scholarship. If you are considering Wofford College, please see your guidance counselor to be nominated for this scholarship. Eligibility: Wofford College applicant, class rank in top 10%, minimum score of 1250 (reading + math) on SAT or 28 composite on ACT, and demonstrate qualities of leadership.

**Kamryn Lambert Foundation Scholarship** – Deadline: April 13, 2012 to SCHS Counseling Center. Eligibility: Senior planning to major in Nursing or a Medical Field. Must write an essay describing an obstacle or adversity you have overcome, and how it has impacted your life. Scholarship Application is available in the Counseling Center.

**The Former Students and Friends of Robert Moton School, Inc** – Deadline: March 30, 2012 to SCHS Counseling Center. Two Awards: The George M. Crawford Scholarship for \$3,000 and The Former Students and Friends of Robert Moton High School Scholarship for \$2,000. Eligibility: Black students graduating from a Carroll County High School. Criteria: GPA, a signed letter discussing your career interests and why you should be considered for the scholarship, at least one letter of recommendation, and a copy of the acceptance letter from the college/university you plan to attend. Application form is in the Counseling Center.

**The Living Legacy Foundation / Donate Life Maryland Scholarship** – Deadline: March 1, 2012. Two Awards: \$500 each. (1) Donate Life Essay Contest: “Be one. Save many.” Write an 800-1,000 word essay about what it means to be a hero and why organ, eye and tissue donors are heroes. (2) Donate Life Poster Contest: “Be One. Save Many.” Create a poster advertisement for organ donation to encourage Marylanders to register as an organ, eye and tissue donor. Eligibility: Maryland high school students (9-12 grades). Contest information/guideline sheets are available in the Counseling Center.

**Piney Run Recreation and Conservation Council Scholarship** – Deadline: March 31, 2012. Two Awards: \$1,000 each. Eligibility: Applicant must be a member or a son/daughter of a member of the Piney Run Nature Center; high school senior; minimum un-weighted GPA of 2.5; minimum SAT score of 1000 or ACT composite of 22-24; and sponsorship of a non-related adult. **Robert H. Clark Memorial Scholarship** – Deadline: March 31, 2012. Award: \$2,500 (renewable up to 4 years). Eligibility: High school senior who is ONE of the following: a) a student at South Carroll, Liberty, or Century High School, b) a student who lives within the boundaries of those schools, c) is a member of St Joseph’s Catholic Community, OR d) is the child of a member or deceased member of Council 7612. Application is available in the Counseling Center.

**Carroll Players Scholarship** – Deadline: April 15, 2012. Award: \$500. Eligibility: Carroll County student who plans to pursue the dramatic arts in college. Theater does not have to be your major. Student must plan on using Theater in their chosen field of study (Drama teacher, stage craft, drama therapy, etc.). Application is available in the Counseling Center.

**CCEA Scholarship** – Deadline: March 31, 2012. Two Scholarships. Applications are available in the Counseling Center.

- (a) **CCEA Future Teacher Scholarship Grant** – Awarded to any student entering college with a major in education regardless of whether or not they are the child or grandchild of a member. All applicants must attend Carroll County Public Schools.
- (b) **CCEA Membership Scholarship Grant** – Awarded to children or grandchildren of current, retired, or deceased CCEA members regardless of the recipient's educational goals or place of residence.

**Tevis College Arts Scholarship** – Deadline: April 20, 2012. Award: \$750. Eligibility: Applicants must be high school seniors residing in Carroll County and planning to pursue a degree in the arts at an accredited college located in the U.S. Application is available in the Counseling Center and online at [www.carrollcountyartscouncil.org](http://www.carrollcountyartscouncil.org).

**JROTC Scholarship** – The Fort Meade Officers' Spouses' Club (FMOSC) award – Deadline: April 1, 2012. Eligibility: Minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5; graduating from high school in spring of 2012; must be currently enrolled in a JROTC program at a high school located within a 35 mi radius of Ft Meade, MD (incl Century HS), and applicant must apply and attend as a full-time student for 2012-2013 at an accredited institution. **Masonic Charities of Maryland** – Grand Lodge of A.F. & A.M. of MD – Deadline: March 31, 2012. Return completed application to the Counseling Center. Award: \$1,000. Eligibility: Any high school senior graduating this academic year from a public high school within the State of Maryland and pursuing a post-secondary education in any state at an accredited institution. Must be a U.S. citizen. Application is available in the Counseling Center.

**Maryland Association of Elementary School Principals Scholarship** – Deadline: April 13, 2012. Award: \$1,000. Eligibility: Graduating Maryland public high school senior in 2012 and plan to pursue an elementary teaching degree at a college, trade school or university in the state of Maryland. Application is available in the Counseling Center and online at: [www.wcps.k12.md.us](http://www.wcps.k12.md.us) – click on “our schools”, then “elementary”, scroll down to Maugansville Elementary and click on “More Info”. Click on “Ken Mann Scholarship Information and Application”.

**Carroll County NAACP Branch 7014 Continuing Education Award** – Deadline: April 10, 2012. Award: \$1,000. Eligibility: Applicant must be a minority student of African American descent that is graduating from a public Carroll County high school, unweighted GPA of 2.5 or greater, and accepted in a college, university or certified trade school as a full time student. Application is available in the Counseling Center.

**Eldersburg Elementary School PTA Scholarship** – Deadline: March 31, 2012. Award: \$1,000. Eligibility: Graduating seniors who are former Eldersburg Elementary students. Application is available in the Counseling Center.

**Carroll County Association for Family & Community Education Scholarship** – Deadline: April 15, 2012. Two Awards: \$500 each. Eligibility: Graduating senior residing in Carroll County. Award will be based on: need, academic standing (top 25% of graduating class), and extracurricular activities. Application is available in the Counseling Center and at the Carroll County Extension Office in Westminster.
