## AP Fee Waivers



### **What is it?**

A fee waiver is assistance provided by Carroll County that can offer reduced fee or free AP exams.

### **Why use it?**

This can help a student take an exam or sign up for multiple exams when finances are the drawback.

## *Are Your Students Taking Advantage of FLEX?*

Students can be attending teacher led review sessions, forming AP study groups that meet during FLEX, and getting extra help throughout the course. Make sure students sign up for FLEX and Take Advantage of this new time during the school day!!

## How do I Qualify for an AP Fee Waiver?

Your child may qualify for fee waivers if your family meets one or more of the following criteria:

1. Your child currently **receives** Free or Reduced Lunch.
2. Your child **qualifies** for Free or Reduced Lunch. If you think your child may qualify for Free and Reduced Lunch but have not registered, please have your child visit the School Counseling Office to pick-up a form. The information we collect is confidential and the application process is straight-forward and discrete. If you would like to learn more, please feel free to visit the Main Office or contact Terry Cooper for more information.
3. Your family's income is at or below the following thresholds:

Size of Family Unit	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
Annual Family Income*	\$20,036	\$26,955	\$33,874	\$40,793	\$47,712	\$54,631	\$61,550	\$68,469

- For family units with more than eight members, add the following dollar amount for each additional family member: \$6,919 for the 48 contiguous U.S. States
4. Your family receives assistance under part A of Title IV of the Social Security Act.
  5. The student is eligible to receive medical assistance under the Medicaid program under title XIX of the Social Security Act.

**The COST of this year's exams is \$87.**
