COURSE SELECTION WORKSHEET INSTRUCTIONS

Course selection is a very important process and should reflect your educational and career goals. You should rely on the advice of your parents, advisors, teachers, and school counselors. Refer to the 2012/2013 South Carroll High School Program of Studies for course descriptions and information about graduation requirements. Teacher Recommendations:

Current teachers are encouraged to initial to the left of academic course(s) they recommend the student select. This is only a recommendation and will, in no way, override student/parent request.

Many of you want to continue your education after graduating from high school. The Program of Studies includes admissions requirements for the University of Maryland system. Use this as a guide in determining the best courses for you to take if you are college bound.

All attempts will be made to schedule the courses as selected. The school administration, however, reserves the right to withdraw any course which has little student demand or when teacher services are not available for that course.

1. **Use PENCIL.**
2. Complete the boxed in section at the top of your worksheet first including name, phone number, parent signature, and post high school plans. **This is required.**
3. Select courses which a) will allow you to meet graduation requirements and b) are consistent with your selected post High School plans.
4. Select First Choice Courses By:
 - a) Placing an "X" in the box to the LEFT of the course number.
 - b) Teachers will need to recommend level 1 courses.
 - c) **Credits must add to a total of 8.**
5. **PHYSICAL EDUCATION:** A student may take no more than one (1) credit per year of any individual course such as: Weight Training, Personal Fitness, Team Sports, etc.
6. You **must** complete the Alternate Course Request section, found on the back of your course selection worksheet, for any course you selected which is noted with ♦ as requiring an alternate.
7. Elective choices should challenge students and reflect academic needs whether college bound or career bound. Carefully consider Completer Program requirements, college entrance requirements, possible college major, or career work plans.
8. **Juniors / Seniors** – may be student aides, for credit only and for no more than a total of 1.0 credit per school year. Students will be able to aide for only one period out of four during any quarter. Students interested in being an aide should see the Department Chair for the requested department for an application. Student will be required to attach the approved application to the course selection sheet.
9. **PARENTS MUST SIGN THE COURSE SELECTION SHEET.** A parent's signature indicates approval of the course selections and alternates as listed. A parent's signature also indicates support of school policy regarding schedule adjustments. Changing of course requests is greatly discouraged as textbooks and instructional materials are purchased based upon course selections made now.
10. **DEADLINE FOR COMPLETION:** Please bring your completed course selection sheet with you to your Advisory Scheduling Conference on February 8. If you are unable to attend a scheduling conference, turn in your course selection sheet to your advisor on or before February 8.
