FERPA

- The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act
- Access to Educational Records
- Control over disclosure of information
 - Student's Grade
 - Student's Behavior
 - Posted Work with Grades

CIPA

Children's Information Protection Act

- Meant to limit exposure to explicit content
- Schools and libraries operate "a technology protection measure with respect to any of its computers with Internet access that protects against access through such computers to visual depictions that are obscene, child pornography, or harmful to minors".

CIPA

Children's Information Protection Act

- School Systems must provide a filter
- School Systems must provide supervision
