SIGNS & SYMPTOMS of HEAD INJURY
Parent/Guardian Notification
(Attach to SASI Report)

Listed below are some of the symptoms, which may occur requiring immediate medical attention and should be referred:

- Weakness in either arms or legs
- Vomiting
- Increasing drowsiness or hyperactivity
- Slowing of pulse or rapid and weak pulse
- Continued headache
- Stiffness in neck
- Blood or clear fluid dripping from ears or nose. **DO NOT** blow a bloody nose or attempt to clean blood from ears or nose.
- Seizures
- A change in temperature
- Difficulty with Speech
- Unequal pupils
