Leo Club

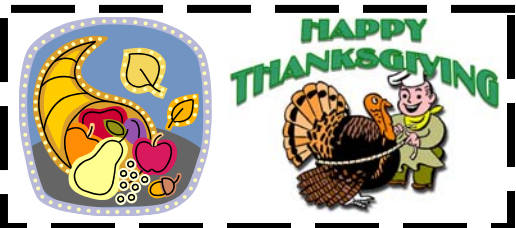
- Holding a coat drive to benefit those who cannot afford coats.
