

Who Do I Ask For Recommendation Letters?

Typically, a college application will require you to submit two or three letters of recommendations from adults who know you well. Once you've begun your college search and find a college you want to apply to, approach the adults who know you and your work very well to ask them for a recommendation letter.

For a teacher or counselor to have all the information they need to write a complete and well-rounded letter of recommendation, students are asked to visit the School Counseling Office and fill out the Senior Credential Sheet. This information sheet will provide details of all of the student's extra-curricular activities both in school and the community, awards and post-secondary plans.
