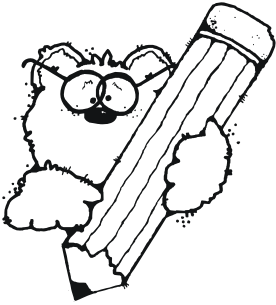

### Raz-Kids Reading Website

**Here is how to access the website and your child's reading assignment from any computer connected to the Internet:**

1. Go to [www.raz-kids.com](http://www.raz-kids.com) from your Internet browser and click on

**Log In**

2. Type in the teacher's username \_\_\_\_\_ and click *GO*.

3. Find your name or symbol on the chart and click on that symbol.

4. The books in your child's assignment and stars earned appear on a personal assignment page. Your child can choose to listen, read, or take a quiz by clicking on the symbols below each book. As your child reads, your child can earn rewards to build a spaceship. You can see the progress by the check marks and the graph on the page. Your child's teacher will be able to see progress made on this site throughout the year.
