Maryland has entered into a fiscal contract with the College Board that allows public and private schools to provide AP exam fee waivers to students who qualify based on one of several criteria. Getting a test fee waiver(s) means that an exam can be taken at *no cost*. **Please review the conditions below and check all that apply to your family.**

- My child is eligible for the free or reduced lunch program
- Our family receives assistance under Part A of Title IV of the Social Security Act
- My child is eligible to receive medical assistance under the Medicaid Program under Title XIX of the Social Security Act
- Our family is experiencing a temporary hardship that may qualify us [*you MUST contact your School Counselor if you may qualify based upon a temporary circumstance*]
- My child is a member of a family whose taxable income for the preceding year did not exceed 150% of the poverty level as established by the US Census Bureau. The table below lists annual family incomes, by family size at 150% of the poverty level
