## Out of District Requests for the 2009-2010 School Year



Out of District Request Forms are available in the guidance office. Board policy states that students attending Carroll County Public Schools shall attend school in their designated attendance area. However, in very specific circumstances, students may be placed in a school outside their attendance area if an approvable circumstance is deemed to exist. Parents/legal guardians desiring an out-of-district placement for their child should carefully review

the list of approvable circumstances listed on the back of the out-of-district application to determine whether the child meets the criteria for approval. The Carroll County Public Schools' out-of-district policy and regulation will be strictly adhered to in making decisions regarding admission of students to schools outside of their assigned attendance area. Parents/legal guardians who plan to submit out-of-district applications for the 2009-2010 school year need to be aware of the following procedures:

- It is the parent's/legal guardian's responsibility to obtain an out-of-district application from the school office or the Student Services Department. Please be certain that the application obtained is for the **2009 – 2010** school year. Completed out-of-district applications may not be returned to the school office.
- The deadline for out-of-district applications for the 2009-2010 school year is **April 1, 2009**. Completed applications must be **postmarked or personally**
