



## **AUTOMOBILES - STUDENT PARKING**

All student drivers must purchase a valid Winters Mill High School parking tag and display that tag whenever parked on school property. Fee for a parking tag is \$20.00. Applications for parking permits will be available in the first day of school and in the Main Office following that date.

**Students who owe obligations will not be issued a parking permit.**

Student drivers are to maintain studies so as not to fail any subject in a marking period. If a student driver becomes ineligible, parking privileges may be revoked for 45 school days.

Good attendance and punctuality are necessary. Unlawful absence from school or class cutting may be grounds for suspension of the driving privilege. **Further, excessive tardiness to school may result in suspension of the driving privilege. Note: Lateness because of car trouble, etc., is not an excused reason for tardiness.**

## **STUDENT PARKING RESTRICTIONS**

All student parking is located in the lot closest to the gymnasium.

**Freshman and Sophomores** may not park on school grounds without special permission from Mr. Baugher. Parking is available on a first come-first serve basis.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

In exchange for the parking privilege, student drivers will:

1. **Lock vehicles and proceed into the school building immediately upon parking the vehicle. No loitering is allowed on parking lots.**
2. Park in designated spaces only. Student vehicles are not to be parked on the grass or on school roadways.
3. Refrain from entering parking lots or vehicles during the school day. If a student must retrieve something from a vehicle, that student should have a pass signed by an administrator.
4. Move cars from parking spaces during the school day only if leaving grounds for early dismissal or if sent home ill through the Health Suite. Student drivers are not permitted to drive around or leave campus during the school day.
5. **Student drivers who are excessively tardy(4)/absent(3) unexcused during a nine week grading period will have their driving privileges revoked for the remainder of the marking period or a minimum of 10 school days. Additional unexcused tardies/absences will result in driving privileges being revoked again for an extended period.**
6. **Students that receive one or more failing grades for a quarter will lose driving privileges for the following quarter.**

## **PENALTIES AND SUSPENSIONS**

Any student who does not follow the above rules and regulations may temporarily lose driving privileges.

**Any student who provides transportation from school grounds for another student without proper authorization from a school administrator, will have driving privileges suspended for a minimum of one calendar month.**

### **Reckless Driving**

Since student safety is of paramount importance, reckless driving will not be tolerated. Reckless driving is defined as driving in an unsafe manner, and includes but is not limited to exceeding the 15 mph speed limit on school property, failing to follow one-way and yield signs, driving on non-designated driving areas such as grassy areas, sidewalks, etc., cutting in between busses, or failing to follow directions of administrators, hall monitors, or teachers supervising parking lots and roadways. Students who drive recklessly will have their driving privileges suspended or revoked. Reckless drivers may also face suspension from school. The following guidelines will be used for reckless driving:

1<sup>st</sup> Offense-Suspension of driving privileges for 30 days

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense- Suspension of driving privileges for the remainder of the semester or 60 days.

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense- Suspension of driving privileges for the remainder of the school year or 60 days.
