BOARD POLICY IHBA: PROGRAM FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Carroll County Public Schools provides a full continuum of services to meet the needs of students with disabilities. Programs and services range from consultive support within the general education environment through a continuum up to a seven-day per week, twenty-four hour per day residential program. The individual needs of the student are addressed through an Individualized Education Plan (IEP).

Each Carroll County Public School designates an appropriate group of individuals to serve as members of a student's Individualized Education Program team. The team shall include at least one general educator who has familiarity with the student and his/her needs, an administrator or their designee, a special educator, appropriate related service personnel, and the parent.

A student with a disability shall have his/her IEP reviewed at least annually. A parent, or staff member may request a more frequent review of the IEP in an effort to determine the appropriateness of the program, services, or level of need.

Students with disabilities are included in all state and local school system assessments with their results reported with the general education students. Individual assessments pertaining to qualifying a student as having a disability shall not be reported to the public.
