ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS**

BOARD POLICY IIBE: DRAMATIC PRODUCTIONS

Dramatic productions provide students with a vehicle to express themselves and communicate with the community. Since expression in the dramatic arts often deals with serious issues, the following administrative regulations regarding the approval process will be used for the selection of drama productions.

The drama director at each school will select a production for approval of the principal based on:

- student interest
- student ability
- diversity of style
- subject matter

The principal will be supplied with a full script by the drama director. The drama director will meet with the principal to discuss the production proposal and the challenges of the proposed production. The principal will evaluate the subject matter based on:

- community norms
- age appropriateness of the material
- strategies for handling the subject material in a school-appropriate way
- cultural sensitivity

The principal may contact the Supervisor of Fine Arts as a resource for input regarding the proposed production prior to granting approval for the production.
