ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS**

**BOARD POLICY IKFF: PLACING STUDENTS FROM A NON-ACCREDITED
SCHOOL OR PROGRAM**

(Section IX, Administrative Regulation, Graduation Requirements)

1. Non-accredited School Credits

- a. The principal shall ascertain whether the school or schools previously attended by the student are accredited. If there is any doubt on this point, an official inquiry shall be addressed to the State Department of Education in the state in which the school or schools are located. If the school or schools are approved by that state, credits may be granted to the student in the subjects that the student has completed.
- b. A local Superintendent of Schools shall determine by an evaluation of a student whether the credits earned at a non-accredited high school will be accepted at the public high school to which the student transfers. This evaluation may include administration of standardized tests and examinations, the use of interviews, as well as the inspection of transcripts, report cards, and other documentation. The student shall be notified in writing of the reasons for any failure to transfer credits from non-accredited schools.
