**BOARD POLICY JA: PEER FACILITATING**  
(Section F, Administrative Regulation: Guidelines for Students=  
Responsibilities and Rights)

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A. Peer Facilitators

1. Definition: A peer facilitator is a student who advises, facilitates and serves as an advocate to other students.
2. Purpose: The peer facilitator program formalizes the opportunity for students to discuss problems and concerns with other students who are trained as listeners.
3. Objectives:
  1. Act as a facilitator in interpreting the Student Code and the individual school=s Student Handbook
  2. Based upon the student=s individual needs, refer him or her to counselors or other resource persons
4. Designated peer facilitators meet standards of acceptability jointly agreed upon by the school administration and Student Services and have completed the necessary training under the auspices of the Student Services Department of the Carroll County Public Schools.
