ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS**

BOARD POLICY JIBB: STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE ON THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

The Student Representative on the Board of Education is elected annually by the Carroll County Student Government Association (CCSGA).

Candidate applications are due to the CCSGA Advisory on a date not preceding one week after the winter break; such date shall be announced by the beginning of winter break. Candidates are interviewed by the CCSGA Executive Board and the top three students are required to present remarks and participate in a question and answer session.

The Student Representative is elected by secret ballot and the candidate receiving plurality from the General Assembly serves as Student Board Representative-Elect for a period of one year prior to being seated on the Board of Education the following June.

The Student Representative will be provided the opportunity to vote on issues, except for personnel matters to indicate the position of the students. This vote will be recorded but will not count in the determination of action.

The Student Representative is required to attend and may provide a brief report about student activities and concerns at all regular Board of Education meetings except Executive sessions involving confidential information.

The Student Representative serves on the Executive Board of both the Carroll County Student Government Association and the Maryland Association of Student Councils (MASC).
