



Carroll County Public Library (CCPL) is a nationally-ranked four-star library providing our community with lifelong learning experiences through programming, resources, and services with an emphasis on offering accessibility to emerging technology. CCPL offers educational and entertaining programming for kids, teens, and adults, both in person and online. With your library card, you can access hundreds of professional online educational resources, thousands of books, eBooks, audiobooks, magazines and newspapers, streaming movies, TV shows and music for free. Speaking of free, CCPL is fine free, having shelved late fees in 2020. Connect to the net with our free WiFi inside and surrounding our locations. Customers have access to meeting rooms, 3D printing, passport services (Eldersburg and North Carroll locations only), and notary services. Visit any of our six locations: Eldersburg, Finksburg, Mount Airy, North Carroll, Taneytown, and Westminster.

Soon, Carroll County Public Library will open Exploration Commons at 50 East in the lower level of the Westminster Branch. Exploration Commons at 50 East is an interactive space where people, ideas and tools come together to create, innovate and collaborate in a makerspace, teaching kitchen, and meeting spaces.

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
