Marking Up Words (A Wilson Technique)

For Marking Up Words, you may have students:

- underline the two letters that make one sound (digraph) <u>thick</u>
- underline each of the separate sounds in a consonant blend $\underline{s} \underline{p} \underline{r} \underline{i} \underline{n} \underline{t}$
- mark the vowels with the short vowel sound (breve) ${f C}{f a}{f p}$

or the long vowel sound (macron) $t\bar{a}pe$

- scoop the syllables fan tas tic
- label the syllable type CUP cake
 c v-e
- circle the "bossy r" CODN
- circle the vowel team **bait**
- circle suffixes chips
