## Memorandum of Understanding

Between the Board of Education of Carroll County (Hereinafter "County Board" or "Board") and

the Carroll County School Food Services Association (Hereinafter "Association" or "CCSFSA")

Regarding

Establishing a specific pay rate for food service workers and managers participating in CCPS student academic recovery and compensatory services programs.

**WHEREAS**, the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic has posed numerous challenges and disruptions to the 2021-22 school year; and

**WHEREAS**, the pandemic has placed burdens on CCPS officials, employees, parents, and students; *and* 

NOW THEREFORE, intending to be legally bound, hereby, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. This MOU does not constitute a permanent modification of the Master Agreement and does not extend beyond the time periods stipulated herein.
- 2. This MOU shall not alter any terms of the Master Agreement.
- 3. This agreement is not setting precedent or past practice.
- 4. The Board shall pay all Food Service workers and managers who participate in-person in the CCPS Academic Recovery and Compensatory Services food delivery programs during summer 2022 (all work June 16 through August 26, and summer meals specific work August 29- Sept. 2) at an hourly rate of 1.5 times the regular school year contracted wage rate.
