This award winning program continues to provide a college preparatory program that will give you the opportunity to learn and to develop the skills needed to continue your education in the fast growing health field. One important aspect of the Academy of Health Professions is that you can select the career path which meets your career interest. There are two options that lead to a variety of clinic/internship experiences.

<u>Nursing</u>: This option provides students interested in pursuing a career in nursing/patient care the opportunity to qualify to complete the testing to become a Certified Nursing Assistant. Students must complete each of the following one credit courses:

Honors Foundations of Medicine and Science Honors Structures and Function of the Human Body CNA: Theory & Clinical Experience

By completing this option, you will be eligible to apply for Honors Health Care Technician (3 credits) Honors Surgical Technology (3credits)

<u>Medical Specialties:</u> This option provides students interested in pursuing careers in rehabilitation health services which include physical therapy, occupational therapy, sports medicine or perhaps dental hygienist.

Students must complete each of the following one credit courses:

Honors Foundations of Medicine and Science, Honors Structures and Function of the Human Body. Medical Specialties
