Student Eligibility

- Applicant must be a former student/alumnus of Winfield Elementary School.
- Applicant will graduate from South Carroll High School in June 2020.
- Applicant's South Carroll High School transcript (attached) reflects an unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Applicant has been accepted to a 2- or 4- year college, university, technical or a trade school program. His/her plans to begin attending in the summer or fall of 2020.

Selection Criteria

- Completion of the scholarship application. Deadline: May 8, 2020.
- Application must have good academic standing. Please attach an official high school transcript.
- Essay – “Why Is It Important To Me to Give Back To My Community?” (500 words or less)  
Include any community volunteer work that you have done and its impact on you personally. Looking to the future, how do you see yourself involved in your community? What community efforts or challenges are most important to you and how can you be an asset?
