Inclement Weather Procedures while in Hybrid Model:

In the event of inclement weather on a Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, or Friday, we will be reverting to the typical snow day policies. This means that should schools close on any of these days due to inclement weather, there will be no instruction and it will be considered a snow day. Should schools open 2 hours late due to inclement weather on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, or Friday, instruction will begin 2 hours later than the usual start time.

If we experience inclement weather on a Wednesday, when all students are scheduled to be in virtual learning, instruction will continue as planned. There will be no school delays or snow days on Wednesdays.

Please remember the follow guidelines regarding self-screening your child/ren each day before they go off to school:

Parent/Guardian/Student Guidelines

- Parents/guardians will self-screen their children. Please do not send your child to school if they have the following. If these symptoms exist, please contact your child's school immediately.
 - **One of these symptoms:**
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath
 - Difficulty Breathing
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Known exposure to someone who is COVID19 positive
 - Positive COVID19 test within 10 days
 - Notification from the health department, your employer, a healthcare provider, or school nurse that you need to isolate or quarantine
 - Fever of 100 degrees or higher

○ **Two or more of these symptoms:**

- Chills or shaking chills
- Muscle Aches
- Sore Throat
- Headache
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Congestion
- Runny Nose
