

**Dear District 5 Schools,**

Attached please find the 2021-2022 Senatorial Scholarship Application for District 5 (Senator Ready).

To be eligible for a Senatorial Scholarship, you must attend a Maryland college or university or a private career school. Private career schools must have the Maryland Higher Education Commission's approval to operate and be accredited by a national accrediting association approved by the United States Department of Education.

Students may use the Senatorial Scholarship towards undergraduate studies or graduate studies, and may attend full or part-time while pursuing a college degree. Full-time attendance is defined as twelve credits per semester for undergraduate students and part-time attendance is defined as six to eleven credits per semester for undergraduate students.

**Please mail your application along with his most recent official transcript with a postmark not later than April 20, 2021 in order to be considered for a scholarship for the 2021-2022 academic year.** Mail your application, a copy of your FAFSA and transcripts to Senator Justin Ready, Attn. Emily Van Horn, Legislative Aide. The PO Box address is located at the bottom of the attached application.

If you attend Liberty, Century, South Carroll or Francis Scott Key High- *please make sure that you reside in District 5 PRIOR to applying.* Students residing in District 5, (<http://mdelect.net>) are able to apply to Senator Ready for scholarship. The link will direct you to your elected state officials and the district linked with your home address.
