On your country's page, locate the menu bar on the left side of the screen. Each of the prompts in **bold** can be found on the menu bar.

**Click on Society**>Human Rights to find out what rights are violated by your country's government. You may want to open another tab to use an online dictionary for some of the words. After taking notes, *copy and paste the citation at the bottom of the page into your Works Cited document.*

[Amnesty International](#) select your country by clicking on Countries and then selecting from the alphabetical list. Read through the Overview to find specific human rights issues your country is facing. Also, look through News articles to see recent examples of oppression.

### **Example of Image Format:**

Artist's name or username. "Name of photo/artwork." Medium of the work. *Name of the website*. Date posted, URL address. Date of access.

### **Example of Video Format:**

Author's last name, author's first name. "Title of the Video." *Title of Website*, uploaded by, Date of upload, URL. Date of access.

### **Example of Website Format:**

Author's last name, author's first name. "Title of article." *Title of Website*, Date of upload, URL. Date of access.
