## **Parking Pass and Student Drop off/ Pick up Information**

As we enter the Hybrid Model, we made some changes to our parking plans. Due to construction and renovations of the Carroll County Career and Tech Center (CCCTC), we will not be able to park in “E” lot. This will reduce the number of available parking spots by 157.

### **PARKING-**

To ensure the maximum number of students parking spots on campus, we have enacted the following guidelines for the 2020-2021 school year:

Student parking will be limited to a total of 438 spots in the “A” lot, stadium lot and the “jock lot”/”C lot”

Seniors and Juniors will be permitted to park on campus with a WHS parking tag. Sophomores and Freshmen will not be able to park on campus this year.

Parking tags will be issued for one semester, fall or spring. Students will be required to purchase a tag each semester. Parking tags will be \$5.00 per semester.

**Parking applications will be accepted from 7:30 AM to 2:30 PM in the visitor management booth. Parking applications must include the \$5 fee,**

**the completed application, and the copy of the registration. Applications can be found on our website under School Forms.**

**Parking tags will be delivered to students on the first day of their hybrid learning cohort. Students who do not report to WHS should pick up their tags at the visitor management booth.**

Students involved in school activities will be granted priority in issuing parking permits.

### **STUDENT DROP OFF/PICK UP-**

The construction will also change the student drop off locations. Student drop off will ONLY take place in the rear of the building. There will be NO student drop -offs in the bus loop, "A", Stadium, or "C"/ "Jock" lot. Traffic should enter campus via the Hook Road/Stadium lot entrance. Traffic will be one-way in the rear of the building starting near the tennis courts and proceeding around behind CCCTC and out the exit onto Washington Rd.
