- **Cultural Arts Programs** – school-wide educational programs to enrich global understanding
- **Education Enhancement** – Special Ed, 6th, 7th & 8th grades and Related Arts funds to defray field trip and various presentations (i.e., China Day, Reptile World)
- **Shiloh Improvement** – technology/office donation- previous donations include copier, smartcart, industrial shredder, tablets and port connectors
- **Staff Appreciation Week & Luncheon** – In May, during Teacher Appreciation Week, we provide a teachers and staff with a ‘thank you’ lunch as well as treats each day!
- **Teacher Classroom Supply Fund** – \$50 reimbursement for PTO member-teacher’s classroom expenses
- **Teacher Conference Dinners**- dinner provided for teachers in-between evening conferences
- **New Friends Event** – incoming 6th graders welcomed with refreshments
- **8th Grade Picnic** – donation of partial funds to celebrate Moving On

Roles of the Shiloh Middle School PTO Board Members

The PTO Board members are President, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President, Treasurer, Recording Secretary and Corresponding Secretary. They are assisted by the Principal, Assistant Principal and appointed Teacher Representative. All PTO Board Members, Administration, and Teacher Rep. attend PTO monthly meetings, assist with events/activities, etc.

PRESIDENT (Vacant): Presides over PTO monthly meetings; oversees events, activities and duties; able to sign checks; liaison between Board Members and administration.

1st VICE PRESIDENT (Vacant): Oversees fundraising/rewards; able to sign checks; takes over if the President is unable to attend a meeting or function.

2nd VICE PRESIDENT (Vacant): Only board member able to make deposits; NOT able to sign check; takes over if the President and 1st VP are unable to attend a meeting or function.

TREASURER (Vacant): Performs bookkeeping; manages the PTO bank account; balances the PTO budget; makes all bank statements available at monthly meetings; and able to sign checks.

RECORDING SECRETARY (Shakira Murphy): Takes minutes at all PTO meetings; prepares the minutes for monthly PTO meetings and sends a copy to the Shiloh website server; maintains current membership.

CORRESPONDING SECRETARY (Vacant): Prepares/mails the PTO newsletter throughout the school year and sends a copy to the Shiloh website server; sends staff correspondence cards/gifts when necessary; maintains the PTO bulletin board.

ADMINISTRATION: Our Principal and Assistant Principals share this role of support and information sharing.

TEACHER REPRESENTATIVE (Jen Goffena): Our staff liaison; voices comments and concerns from the Shiloh staff; relays PTO information and questions back to the Shiloh staff.
